## BME-VIK EIT Digital Scholarship

The Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Informatics, Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME), offers scholarships to top nonEU/EEA applicants enrolled in BME EIT Digital programs. The grant is merit-based, and the ranking is based on the accepted application submitted to EIT Digital Master School. The BME scholarship is up to 2500 EUR per semester for nonEU/EEA students and it cannot exceed 5000 EUR per semester with the EIT Digital tuition fee waiver.

Students are eligible for the grant during the academic year they spend at BME in case they meet the following criteria:

- They submitted their application and were accepted by the EIT Digital Master School.
- They applied to and got admitted to the EIT Digital Master programmes at BME in the entry year of the Autonomous Systems (AUS) or completed all previous study obligations in Embedded Systems (ES) or Data Science (DS) at the entry year institution.
- For entry year students of the AUS programme: To be eligible for the grant for the February-June period, they need to complete $100 \%$ of the course requirements during the first semester and obtain at least 28 ECTS.
- For exit year students of the ES or DS programmes: To be eligible for the grant for the September-January period, they need to submit their transcript of records for the entry year certifying the completion of $100 \%$ of the course work during the entry year, thus obtaining at least 60 ECTS. To be eligible for the grant for the February-June period, they need to complete $100 \%$ of the course requirements during the first semester and obtain at least 28 ECTS.

The applications are evaluated up to $30^{\text {th }}$ of September.
