HKPFS candidates nominated by PolyU to RGC will be offered a PhD place with the award of a PolyU scholarship (mutually exclusive with HKPFS).

THE PROGRAMME

In an equally split study pattern, the Dual PhD Degree Programmes provide full-time PhD students the opportunity to conduct research at PolyU and a prestigious partner university, benifiting from the academic and research excellence of both universities.

Joint PhD Supervision Scheme

THE PROGRAMME

This scheme aims to support the joint supervision of international full-time PhD students from world-renowned universities to conduct research at PolyU as a Research Assistant for a period of 12 months. Monthly financial support will be provided by PolyU during the students' appointment period. Students will have the exciting opportunity to engage in collaborative research projects under the guidance of supervisors from both universities, fostering a rich exchange of ideas and expertise.

ELIGIBILITY

Full-time international PhD students from selected universities

The 12-month Research Assistant appointment period at PolyU must fall within the study period of the student





Pre-PhD Programme

THE PROGRAMME

A taster programme designed to support international Master's students from selected overseas universities to conduct research at PolyU as a Research Assistant under a PolyU host supervisor and experience PolyU's research environment. During the appointment period, the host supervisor will assess the student's suitability to pursue a PhD at PolyU and work towards establishing an early-stage supervisory relationship with the student.

3 to 6 months of research internship at PolyU

ELIGIBILITY

International Master's student from selected overseas universities, whose degree requires a dissertation as an award requirement

Hold a nationality other than Mainland China, Taiwan, Macau or Hong Kong

Demonstrate strong academic performance and high research potential

Have a genuine interest in pursuing a PhD





Research Student Attachment Programme

THE PROGRAMME

Designed to enhance students' global exposure and encourage international research collaborations, the Research Student Attachment Programme (RSAP) supports PhD students to conduct attachment studies both to and from leading universities worldwide ranging from 3 months to 1 year under the guidance of a host supervisor. Currently, the RSAP connects PolyU with a vast network of over 300 institutions in 40 countries, facilitating opportunities for both outgoing and incoming PhD students.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Outgoing Visit:

Subsistence allowance of HK\$250/day (up to 180 days) and a travel allowance of HK\$10,000 (by reimbursement)

Incoming Visit:

Subsistence allowance of HK\$400/day (up to 180 days)

ELIGIBILITY

Outgoing Visit:

Current PolyU PhD students with good academic standing

Incoming Visit:

Current PhD students with good academic standing, whose home institutions are overseas (except mainland China, Macau and Taiwan)

- Able to attend all sessions of the Summer School in person on PolyU campus






